AIM

The European Water Partnership (EWP) acknowledges the commitment to promote and enhance a better involvement of young people in global water issues. As a follow up and outcome of the first European Youth Water Summit an amateur photographic competition "*Who cares ... about water? Nature does!*" is being organized by the EWP inviting young people, aged between 18-25, to capture their interpretation of the title in pictures and to express their view of the interlinkages between water and biodiversity in an artistic manner.

PARTICIPANTS

- The photo competition is open to young people between 18 and 25 years old, living in Europe (as defined by Council of Europe).
- The photo competition is not open to organizers, partners and members of the jury or their families.

RULES²

- Each participant may submit up to 2 pictures.
- The images can be in colour or black & white, should be at least 300dpi resolution, supplied in JPEG format with a maximum file size of 5MB.
- Pictures have to be submitted electronically before Wednesday, 26th May 5pm Brussels time to click@ewp.eu and in the subject of the email „Aquawareness Photo Competition“
- To participate in the competition, candidates must provide the organizers with personal information (name, address, birth date etc.) and 2-5 sentences describing the image and the place where the picture was taken.
- Pictures will not be accepted into the competition if they are deemed inappropriate. This includes obvious photo-shop-ing, images that may be offensive, previously published, copyrighted (by somebody other than the entrant) or otherwise contrary to the spirit of the competition or any of the specific rules noted before.
- Pictures which do not comply with these rules will not be considered.

WINNER SELECTION

All works will be exhibited during Europe's most prominent environmental conference, the Green Week, to be held in Brussels, 1-4 June 2010. Visitors of the Green Week Exhibition, a high level jury, and online votes on the EWP website will select the winning pictures.

CRITERIA

The competition will examine photographer's skills, creativity, the artistic realization of the title and the intercultural comprehensibility.

PRIZES

The winners will be invited to receive attractive prizes at the Aquawareness photo competition award ceremony, taking place in a European capital in autumn 2010. Place and date of the ceremony will be released soon.
